SEMESTER 2 REPORTS

When reading the report, it is important to remember that 'Sound' achievement indicates that your child is making progress in relation to what he or she was expected to learn over the Semester – meaning your child is on track with his or her peers. Student reports also include information on your child's level of effort and teacher comments on ability in each Key Learning Area. Included with your report will be stage statements from the English and Maths syllabus for the achievements by the end of Years Kindergarten, Year 2, Year 4 and Year 6. This will outline the learning that students will work toward and assist in the understanding the comments of your child's report. If you wish to discuss your child's progress or any other issue, please contact your child's teacher to make an appointment.

REWARDS DAY

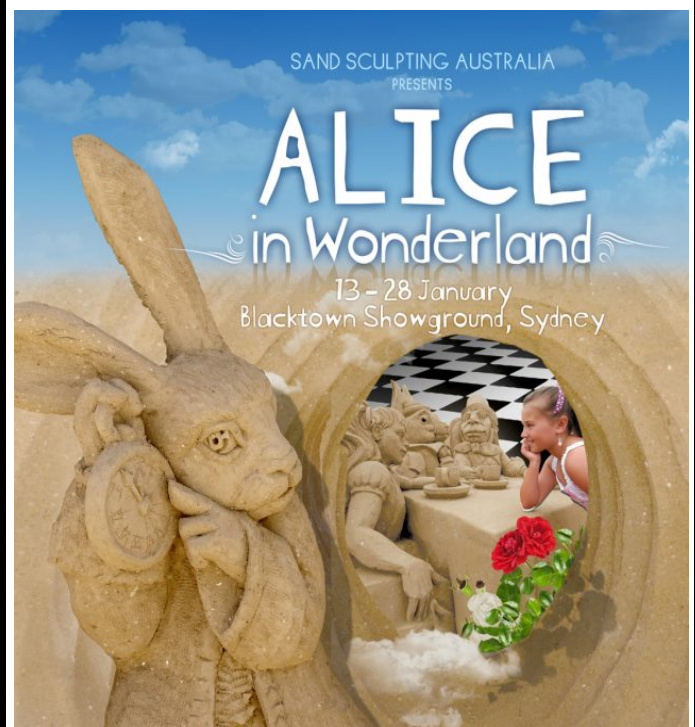
