Incursion

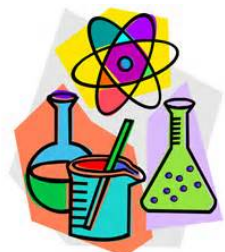
On Tuesday the 13th of November Mr Cartner, the head science teacher at Kariong Mountains High school brought 9 of his year 9 selective class students to our school. They came to teach 5/6 about science.

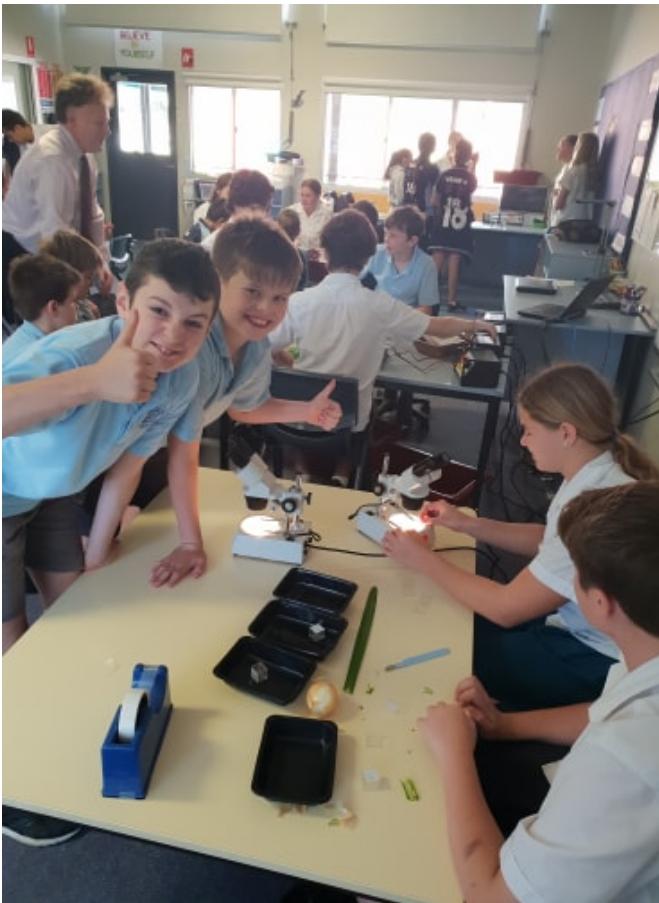
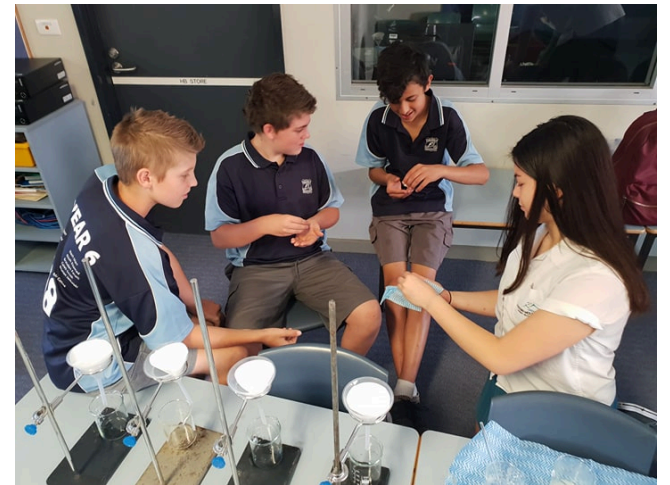
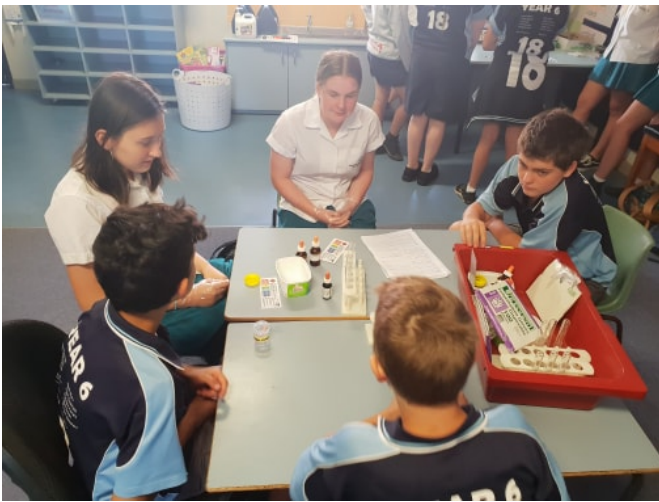
There were 5 science activities: boiling water with wire, turning dirty water into clean water, turning milk and vinegar into clay, measuring the ph. of acids, water and bases, seeing how many nails and paper clips the magnet can carry and last but not least, we had to put sticky tape on the floor rip it off and look at the particles we picked up. There was a lot of hairs, we also got to see a finger print.

We did it for an hour and a half. When we looked at the PH level for acid base and liquid, the acid was red so the PH level was ph5 which the lowest we could get. The base was PH10 and the water was PH 6–7.

Every one in 5/6 enjoyed the science day. I personally thought it was a really great experience and so did some of my fellow pupils.
