The report will include a five-point achievement scale that summarises the standard (or quality) of achievement associated with each grade and describes:

- The range of skills that students working at that standard typically show.

Teachers are using achievement data and participation notes to give a rounded summary of your child's progress. Each year we invite parents to contact the school if they have concerns about their child's learning. I'm looking forward to reading the students' reports in the coming weeks.
