These classes help students to learn by grouping them with students of similar ability, using specialised teaching methods and educational materials at the appropriate level. A reminder that during the holidays our school is open as part of the Share our Space program. This initiative is an extension to community land such as playgrounds and other open spaces in our local area. Access to outdoor spaces is vital to the health and wellbeing of our communities and allows the public to enjoy daily exercise. Families are welcome to use the facilities at school to relax, play and exercise. A reminder that children need to always have parental supervision.

This Friday our Year 4 & 5 students will attend a leadership workshop with **Kids Help Line**. As our senior students move onto high school, we prepare students to be ready to show qualities of being a leader at our school. End of Year Incursion - as a part of our end of




year celebration **Raptor Reptiles** will be visiting Kulnura PS on **15 December – 1-2:30pm.** There will be no cost to families for this event.

Functionality for parents within the Compass parent portal includes the ability to:


- Monitor their child's attendance and enter in explanations for late arrivals or absences.
































KPS 1 – Propagating Citronella with Mr Collins
