are ready and prepared to continue learning for our students for the coming year.

ScopelT will again be at our school during Term 1. ScopelT Education has been proudly helping schools on the Central Coast since 2015 with in-school lessons in all things technology. Compass Parent Portal – 2023

Next week KPS will be launching our Parent Portal via Compass. Parents/Carers will be able to view information pertaining to their child/children, complete various actions (i.e., enter attendance notes, consent/pay for events etc) and access information posted to them by staff at the school. Parents/Carers will have the ability to:

- Monitor their child's attendance and enter in explanations for late arrivals or absences.
- Communicate with their child's teachers and update their family contact details.
- Download and view their child's progress and semester reports.
- View 'My News', a news feed of school announcements, alerts and updates.
- View the school calendar.
- Pay and provide consent for events, excursion and school fees.

Access to the above items will be implemented over a few weeks. Parents/carers will receive information and passwords next week via email on how to set up their portal access.

School uniform is one aspect of school that gives students an identity and sense of pride. Our uniform is a sky/navy blue polo shirt and navy shorts or skirt with black joggers.
